

Company History: The Evolution of Tempo Communications

The Tempo story started in 1984 as Tempo Research Corporation, a company renowned for its high-quality and reliable tones and probes, [SideKick](#), and other [test and measurement](#) equipment aimed at the communications technician.

In 2001, Tempo was acquired by Textron, Inc. as it focused on growing its telecommunications portfolio. Textron also owned Greenlee Electric, and in 2008 Tempo's name was changed to Greenlee Communications to fall under Textron's Greenlee umbrella.

In 2018, Greenlee Communications was acquired by Emerson Electric (along with Greenlee Electric). By this time, Greenlee Communications had expanded its test and measurement equipment offerings to also include solutions into areas like [Ethernet](#) and [Wi-Fi](#).

On January 31, 2019, Greenlee Communications was purchased by a group of private investors and its name was officially changed to Tempo Communications, Inc., bringing the company back, full circle, to the trusted name with which it began back in 1984.
